- Accolade Wines has a commitment to privacy in accordance with the applicable privacy laws in the countries in which we operate and are committed to protecting and maintaining your privacy. 3 WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION DO WE COLLECT?

The categories of personal information about you which we may collect are:

- (a) Individual Data which includes personal information which relates to your identity, such as your first name, middle name, last name, username or similar identifier, marital status, title, date of birth and gender, and your billing address, delivery address, email address and telephone numbers which you provide to us in person, via our website, apps or by telephone;
- (b) Account and Profile Information which includes personal information which relates to your account with us or profile on our website or apps, such as your username and password, purchases or orders made by you, your interests, preferences, feedback and survey responses;

- (c) **Economic and Financial Information** which includes personal information which relates to your finances, such as your bank account and payment card details and, for the purposes of the prevention of fraud, such personal information may also include your passport (where you provide this to us) and any VAT registration details;
- (d) Sales Information which includes personal information which relates to the transactions you have conducted with us, such as details about payments to and from you, details of subscriptions to our services or publications and other details of products and services you have purchased from us;
- (e) **Information Technology Information** which includes personal information which relates to your use of our website or apps, such as your IP address, login data, and traffic data;
- (f) Audio and Visual Information which includes personal Information which is gathered using our CCTV or other recording systems at our locations in the form of images, video footage and sound recordings;
- (g) Advertising and Marketing Information which includes personal information which relates to your marketing preferences, such as information about your preferences in receiving marketing materials from us and our third parties and your communication preferences as well as your personal interests (where you provide this to us);
- (h) **Market Research Information** which includes personal information which is gathered for the purposes of market research;
- (i) **Health Information** which includes special personal information which is gathered for health and safety purposes including any accident report or claim log and dietary preferences.

We may also create personal information about you, for example, if you contact us by telephone to make a complaint, for example about our services or goods, then we may make a written record of key details of the conversation so that we can take steps to address the complaint.

We also obtain and use certain aggregated information such as statistical or demographic data for any purpose ("**Aggregated Information**"). Aggregated Information may be derived from your personal information but does not directly or indirectly reveal your identity. For example, we may aggregate your operational information to calculate the percentage of users accessing a specific feature on our website or apps. Information with your personal information so that it can directly or indirectly identify you, we treat the combined data as personal information which will be used in accordance with this Privacy Notice.

In addition, we may from time to time obtain certain special categories of your information including, for example, concerning health ("**Special Categories of Information**"), and this Privacy Notice sets out how we may process these types of personal information. For example, if there was an incident at one of our properties we may need to process your special personal information for health and safety requirements or to complete an accident form.

- external professional advisers such as accountants, auditors, bankers, insurers and lawyers;
- law enforcement agencies, courts or other relevant party, to the extent necessary for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal rights;
- third parties where necessary for the purposes of prevention, investigation, detection or prosecution of criminal offences, including but not limited to fraud prevention, or the execution of criminal penalties;
- third parties which are considering or have decided to acquire some or all of our assets or shares, merge with us or to whom we may transfer our business (including in the event of a reorganisation, dissolution or liquidation);
- third parties operating plugins or content (such as Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) on our website or apps which you choose to interact with.

7 INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 7.1 Personal information we collect from you may be transferred, stored and/or processed outside South Africa. It is possible that your personal information may also be transferred, stored and/or processed in other countries outside South Africa.
- 7.2 Subject to any applicable conditions in each case, such transfers of personal information may be made on the following bases:
 - 7.2.1 where you have given your explicit, specific written consent;
 - 7.2.2 where such transfer is necessary to conclude or perform under a contract;
 - 7.2.3 where the personal information transferred, will be adequately protected after the transfer occurs;
 - 7.2.4 where the transfer is for your benefit; or
 - 7.2.5 where another reason applies so for example the transfer is necessary for legal claims, to protect the vital interests of an individual or necessary for the performance of a contract, public interest or with consent.

8 HOW LONG WE WILL STORE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION FOR

We will store your personal information for the time period which is appropriate and in accordance with our data retention criteria set out below. We keep the length of time that we hold your personal information for under regular review. These reviews take place annually. The criteria include-

- the purpose for which the personal information is used;
- our legal obligations and other legal requirements; and
- the type and amount of information and whether it is special personal information .

9 CONTRACTUAL OR STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS ON YOU TO PROVIDE PERSONAL INFORMATION

- (a) In certain circumstances the provision of personal information by you is a requirement: to comply with the law or a contract; or necessary to enter into a contract.
- (b) It is your choice as to whether you provide us with your personal information necessary to enter into a contract or as part of a contractual requirement. If you do not provide your personal information then the consequences of such failure could mean, for example, that we may not be able to perform to the level you expect under our contract with you.

10 ACCURACY OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

It is important that the personal information we hold about you is accurate and current and we take all reasonable precautions to ensure that this is the case but we do not undertake to check or verify the accuracy of personal information provided by you. 11 YOUR RIGHTS IN RELATION TO YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

- Request access to your personal information: You have the right to confirm, free of charge, whether or not we hold any of your personal information, and to the extent that we do hold your information, to request a copy or description of that record for a prescribed fee. Please contact our information officer should you wish to exercise any of your data subject rights. You will be required to provide adequate proof of your identity so that we can confirm your identity and ensure your right to access your personal information. We may need to request other specific information from you to help us process your request. This is a security measure to ensure that personal information is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it. We may also contact you to ask you for further information in relation to your request to speed up our response.
- Request correction of your personal information: You have the right to request us to correct or delete your personal information which we have in our possession, where it is inaccurate, irrelevant, excessive, out of date, incomplete, misleading or obtained unlawfully.
- Notification that your personal information is being collected: When your personal information is collected, you have the right to be informed that your information is collected and where the information is not collected from you, you have the right to be informed of the source from whom/which it is collected.
- Notification of security compromises: Where reasonable grounds exist for us to believe that your personal information has been accessed or acquired by an unauthorised person, you have the right to be notified.
- Request destruction or deletion of your personal information: You have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal information where there is no good reason for us continuing to process it. You also have the right to ask us to delete or remove your personal information where you have successfully exercised your right to object to processing (see below), where we may have processed your information unlawfully or where we are required to erase your personal information to comply with the law. Note, however, that we may not always be able to comply with your request of destruction or deletion for specific legal reasons which will be notified to you, if applicable, at the time of your request.

- Request the restriction of processing of your personal information: This
 enables you to ask us to suspend the processing of personal information about
 you, for example if you want us to establish its accuracy or the reason for
 processing it.
- Object to processing of your personal information: You have the right to object to our processing of your personal information where we are relying on a legitimate interest (or those of a third party) and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground. You also have the right to object where we are processing your personal information for direct marketing purposes. In some cases, we may demonstrate that we have compelling legitimate grounds to process your information which override your right to object to processing.
- Withdraw consent: You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time where we are relying on consent to process your personal information. However, this will not affect the lawfulness of any processing carried out before you withdraw your consent. If you withdraw your consent, we may not be able to provide certain products or services to you. We will advise you if this is the case at the time you withdraw your consent.
- **Institute civil proceedings:** You have the right to institute civil proceedings regarding the alleged interference with the protection of your personal information.
- Submit a complaint to the Regulator: you have the right to lodge complaints regarding the processing of your personal information with the relevant supervisory authority (which in South Africa is the Information Regulator). The Information Regulator can be contacted via email at POPIAComplaints.IR@justice.gov.za. Please see www.justice.gov.za for how to do this in South Africa.

Glossary

POPIA means the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 and its regulations;

process means any operation or activity or any set of operations, whether or not by automatic means, concerning personal information, including –

- the collection, receipt, recording, organisation, collation, storage, updating or modification, retrieval, alteration, consultation or use;
- dissemination by means of transmission, distribution or making available in any other form; or
- merging, linking, as well as restriction, degradation, erasure or destruction of information,

and processing and processed have corresponding meanings;

responsible party means a public or private body or any other person which, alone or in conjunction with others, determines the purpose of and means for processing personal information; and for the purposes of this privacy policy is Accolade Wines;

special personal information means personal information about race or ethnicity, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, trade union membership, physical or mental health, sexual life, any actual or alleged criminal offences or penalties, biometric information or any other information that is deemed to be sensitive under applicable privacy laws.

Annexure A – Cookies and Accolade Wines websites

Accolade Wines, in common with many website providers, may use standard technology called cookies on its websites. Cookies are small data files that are downloaded onto your computer when you visit a particular website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. This can allow websites to recognise devices throughout the duration of a user's visit or browsing session. These cookies are known as session cookies.

In some cases, cookies persist across multiple browsing sessions, enabling the website to remember user preferences from previous visits. These cookies are known as preference cookies. Both session cookies and preference cookies reduce the requirement for the user to continually identify themselves on their journey through a website. For example, cookies may be used on this website to remember that the user has verified their date of birth, or to remember the details and the choices from submitted forms.

Some third party cookies may be placed on devices used to browse this website. These will typically be social media cookies, used by websites such as Facebook, to aid with the integration between any social media elements that the user may interact with and their social media profiles.
